RE: NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT TO WITHDRAWAL LIABILITY RULES

This notice, which is being issued pursuant to 29 C.F.R. § 4211.22, is to inform all participating employers and local unions in the Bakery and Confectionery Union and Industry International Pension Fund ("the Fund") that the Board of Trustees has adopted an amendment to the Fund's withdrawal liability rules ("the Amendment"). The Amendment, which was adopted on November 7, 2012, will be effective on the date it is approved by the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation ("PBGC").

The Amendment does not change the withdrawal liability rules for employers that currently contribute to the Fund, but creates a new pool of withdrawal liability (the "New Pool"). Employers who begin contributing to the Fund on or after the date the PBGC approves the Amendment will participate in the New Pool, and any withdrawal liability attributable to them will be calculated solely under the New Pool. Additionally, the Fund will use the "direct attribution" method to calculate withdrawal liability under the New Pool.

The Fund will also permit current contributing employers in the Fund to participate in the New Pool by paying their withdrawal liability in the current withdrawal liability pool and becoming a contributing employer to the Fund in the New Pool.
